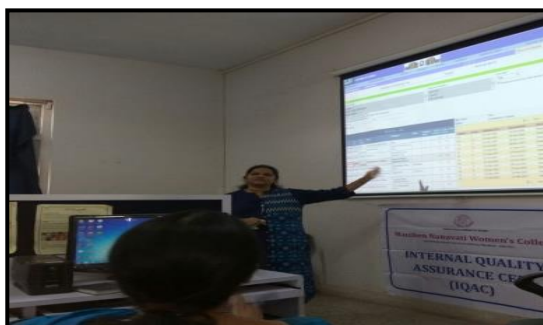

Talk on Landscape Conservation: 6th February, 2018

Mr. Sharad Kale, a retired scientist from BARC, a Padmashree Award winner and also a member of Stree Mukti Sansthan, gave a talk on importance of using water, plastic and household waste for the betterment of environment. He also spoke about his invention of 'Nisarg-Runa' a Bio-Gas plant which converts almost 11000kg of wet waste into Bio-Gas at TISS, BARC & Deonar grounds where it is successfully used. 61 NSS volunteers attended the talk.



Talk on Biodegradable Waste: 5th February, 2018

Objective: To educate students about biodegradable waste & making of manure using the basket method

Ms. Mayuri Shinde from Stree Mukti Sangathan in collaboration with Savitri Bai Phule Seva Sansthan gave a talk on Biodegradable Waste and explained the process of decomposition and gave information about how to convert biodegradable waste into manure and its various uses. She also put up a display of placards in the college premises, on Waste Management methods, Concept of Zero Waste, Solid Waste Management, Journey from Shopping bag to Garbage Bag & Nature's Waste Management methods. 88 NSS volunteers attended the talk.
