# WORKSHOPS/ TALKS ORGANIZED BY IQAC, MNWC

# • Department External Audit 2016-2019: 16<sup>th</sup> April 2019

As per the advisory note on Academic Audits provided by NAAC, the IQAC of Maniben Nanavati Women's College has been undertaking Academic Audits on an annual basis from 2016. Two Audits 2016-2017; 2017-2018, were internally reviewed by Prof. Vibhuti Patel, Professor, Advanced Centre for Women's Studies, TISS, Mumbai, Prof. K. Venkataramani, Former Registrar, Mumbai University and Mr. Suketu Jariwala, Chief Executive Officer & Co-Founder, Torsion Industries, Navi Mumbai

Principal, Dr Rajshree .P. Trivedi decided to constitute a Senior NAAC committee comprising of Principal Dr. Rajshree Trivedi, Dr. Jayashree Palit, Senior NAAC Committee Convener, Dr. Falguni Desai. Senior NAAC Committee Co- Convener, Prof. Sunita Sharma, Senior NAAC Committee Member and Dr. Twinkle Sanghavi, IQAC Coordinator with the objective of preparing a strategy for the External Audit from June 2016 to May 2019, to devise a systematic and scientific method of identifying the strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and challenges of the departments and to enhance the quality of academic activities by chalking out an action plan for the future. They devised a process of external academic audit for Departments that was systematic and transparent.

The experts were given following methodology for the audit.

# A. Before the Visit

- To study the Department Report (DR) and PPT to understand the contribution of the Department to institutional improvement.
- To identify the strengths, weaknesses, opportunities, challenges and points for interaction with the Departments at the time of the visit (16<sup>th</sup> April 2019)

# **B.** During the Visit (16th April 2019)

To interact with the faculty members of each Department to discuss the DR., appraise the Department of the SWOC, to look for documentary evidence, to guide the Department for further improvement.

# • Workshop on "Innovation and Incubation "organized by RUSA

Dr Rita Patil attended the workshop on "Innovation and Incubation" organized by RUSA on 7th February 2019 at Guru Nanak Khalsa College. Dr Vijay Joshi State Project Joint Director (I/C), RUSA, introduced the concept and gave the context setting. Shri Prasad Menon CEO of Centre for Incubation and Business Acceleration spoke on starting and operating an Incubator and entrepreneurship opportunities, about their Incubation center- CIBA- . The details of awareness, pre-incubation, incubation and post incubation, Funding and financing was discussed too. Shri Bikram Mahajan CEO at White box Capital spoke on Role of Incubation center in college to Nurture Entrepreneurship, gave a few examples of incubation centers like Y-combinatory, CIIE and Fintech Hub and linkages. A challenge in Managing an Incubator was presented by Mr. Sushanto Mitra, founder and CEO of Lead Angels suggested- business plan competitions, meet up events, role model meetings and connect with start-up organizations. A workshop on 'NAAC Accreditation Revised: Challenges and Overview' was organized on 16<sup>th</sup> February 2019 by the Affiliation Section of SNDT University. It was attended by Principal Dr. Rajshree Trivedi and Dr. Twinkle Sanghavi, the IQAC Coordinator. The workshop was divided into two sessions- the first session was conducted by Dr. Devandra Kawday, Deputy Adviser 1, NAAC, Bengaluru on, how in new NAAC manual the matrix is given different weightage for University, Autonomous Colleges and Affiliated Colleges, changes in Criteria II and III, the working of IIQA, on Students Satisfactory Survey as the most important key indicator, importance of collecting the feedback from all stake holders, then to analyze and take necessary actions and uploading it on college website. The second session was conducted by Dr. Kurup on Governance, Leadership and Management. He highlighted the importance of College Development Council (CDC), Minutes of IQAC should be well maintained as data base, need for WIFI, and extensive use if ICT in teaching, the importance of incubation center, and Alumni involvement. He said the data from CHB should be taken. Every college should keep the progression of the students in mind. The workshop ended with a few interactive discussions

API Guideline Workshop was organized by IQAC of SNDT Women's University on 25th February 2019 at 2.00 pm in the Committee Room at Church gate Campus. He explained on API guidelines, service book is very important record & employee can keep 2<sup>nd</sup> copy of our service book with them. In pending CAS Cases till 2017 only category 3 will be consider. He has also explained that applicant has to prepared API files according to academic year. He emphasis on quality of research publication and also for research Projects

He explained various amendments of API which were accepted by Maharashtra Government. He also cleared the concept of Co-Author & distribution of grade & new changes in new system. According to New API 2017-18 for the direct recruitment required PhD at entry level & for the literature people the book written by them should be recognized by university & letter of recognition should be attached in API files which will help them in getting full marks. In the question answer session he addressed the common questions & feedback were collected at the end.
