The Shadow Pandemic : Gender Based Violence During COVID 19

The COVID 19 Pandemic for more than a year and half has brought to the fore various issues besides the physical health aspect. The lockdown created conditions that resulted into a sharp increase in the number of cases of violence against, women, children, men and non-binary genders affecting almost all the sections of society. The forms of violence include physical, emotional, psychological and others. Violence in the environment has doubled as cases registered by victims complaint of atrocities and assault coming not only from family members but also from external agencies such as workplace, employers, virtual communities and others stalking and bullying using virtual platforms. Violence and abuse intensify as the abusers are also affected by the unnatural living conditions and they vent their frustrations with greater frequency and intensity. This is a pandemic in itself and unfortunately is not recognised or discussed and hence does not receive any support or help.

With this in mind, the theme for this year's ANVESHAN is to bring out the different aspects of gender based violence - in the context of the COVID-19 pandemic.

- 2. Each team can have 2-4 participants, all from the same institute.

3. Prizes will be given in the following categories:: Category 1- Social Sciences and Humanities Category II- Commerce & Management studies

4. The Competition will be organised in three stages: Stage 1: E-Posters invited from the students of undergraduate and post graduate sections of colleges and universities across India. The posters can be in English or Gujarati. Registration Compulsory. Posters to be sent by 7th JUNE 2021 to ksrc@mnwc.edu.in

Stage II- Full papers of Selected Posters to be submitted by 10th JUNE 2021 to ksrc@mnwc.edu.in. Papers to be in APA style, MS WORD file, 12 fonts, Times New Roman, 3000-5000 words, Title page with name, student details, name of institution, contact details, undertaking for no plagiarism.

Stage III: Selected papers to come for presentation during the Final Event on 25th June 2021. The judges' decision will be considered final.

5. E- Poster Format:

Scientific posters usually rely on clarity and visuals to convey the essence of the paper. Irrespective of the discipline, the rules are usually the same. Please find below some links that will help you design the posters. For stage 1, the posters can be sent on one single PPT slide. No more than one slide is acceptable. If shortlisted, the very same slide needs to be presented during the oral session.

6. Poster Design Guidelines:

Header

Prepare a headline that is reflective of the research, program or intervention. Include the authors and their affiliations (institution/organization) under the header for identification.

Organization

The objective is to present the information clearly and simply in a visually appealing way. Be careful not to overload the poster with text and/or graphics. Please use a consistent style and sequence (left to right or top to bottom) to guide the viewer through the poster. You may use figures, tables, graphs and/or photographs where suitable. Keep the text brief and to the point.

Layout

Posters should include appropriately labeled illustrative graphs and diagrams as much as possible. Long textual passages should be avoided, and the methodology section generally should be brief unless it is the main focus of the abstract. Use a large font size for your text, such as 24-point and arrange materials in columns rather than in rows to make your poster more reader-friendly. Indicate the sequence of tables, figures or graphs with highlighted or colored numbers or letters at least one inch high.

Typography

Avoid using abbreviations, acronyms and/or jargon in your poster. Make sure the font is consistent throughout.

The size and type of poster to be will be conveyed to the shortlisted candidates
