BMS

- For Internal and External Exams, separate passing is necessary. Passing marks for Internal Exam are 10/25 and External Exam are 30/75.
- Students can be allowed to keep terms in 4 or less than 4 papers. Cross ATKTKT is not allowed for the admission in Third Year.

BAFI

- First year Exams of Semester I and II will be conducted by the College.
- Semester III, IV, V and VI exams will be conducted by the University.
- For Internal and External Exams, separate passing is necessary. Passing marks for Internal Exam are 9/25 and External Exam are 26/75.
- Students can be allowed to keep terms in 4 or less than 4 papers. Cross ATKTKT is not allowed for admission in Third Year.

B.Design

- First and Second year Exams of Semester I, II, III and IV will be conducted by the College.
- Semester V, VI, VII and VIII will be conducted by the University.
- For Internal and External Exams, separate passing is necessary. Passing marks for Internal Exam are 10/25, 20/50 and External Exam are 20/50, 30/75, 40/100.
- Students can be allowed to keep terms in 40% of Total Subjects.

POST-GRADUATE COURSES

M.A & M.COM

1. All semester examinations will be conducted by University
2. Each paper carries 100 marks, consisting of Internal (50 marks) and External (50 Marks) except Internship paper in Semester IV. Internship paper consists of Internal (100marks) and External (100Marks).
3. The minimum marks of passing in internal will be 20 & in external will be 20 for 50 mark paper. The minimum marks of passing in internal will be 40 & in external will be 40 for 100 mark paper.
4. If the student will not score passing marks in internal examination, she will not be eligible for external examination.
5. The standard passing for each subject and overall will be 40%
6. Degree will be awarded based on student's performance in all 4 semesters taken together.
