Main General rules for writing in a resume individual should follow Century Schoolbook, Courier, Time New Roman and advised not to use more than one font (Heading 18, sub heading 14 and content 12). She briefed about few HR software which takes only six seconds for scanning each Resume/CV and shared examples of few Resume/CV related with industry Job requirement.

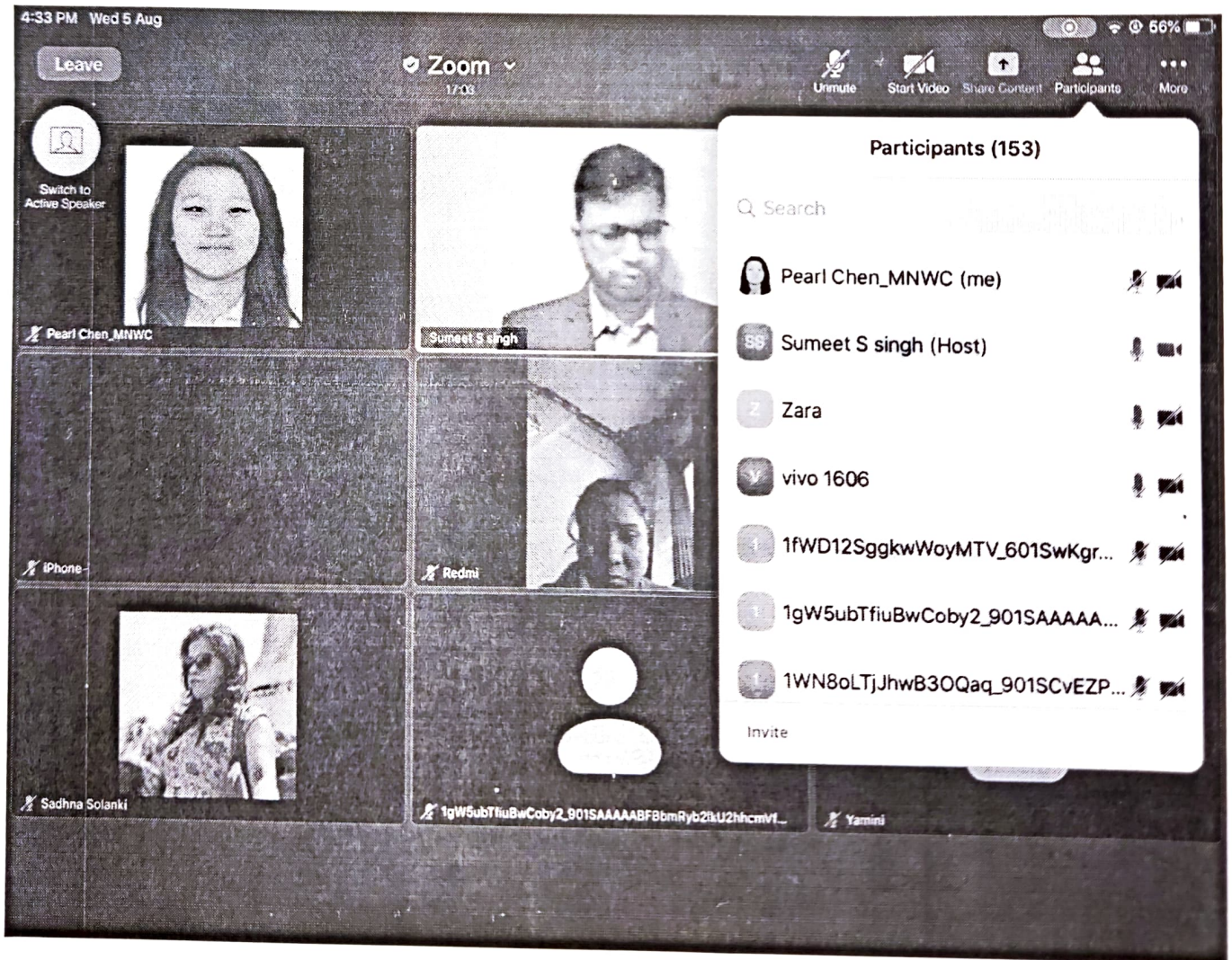
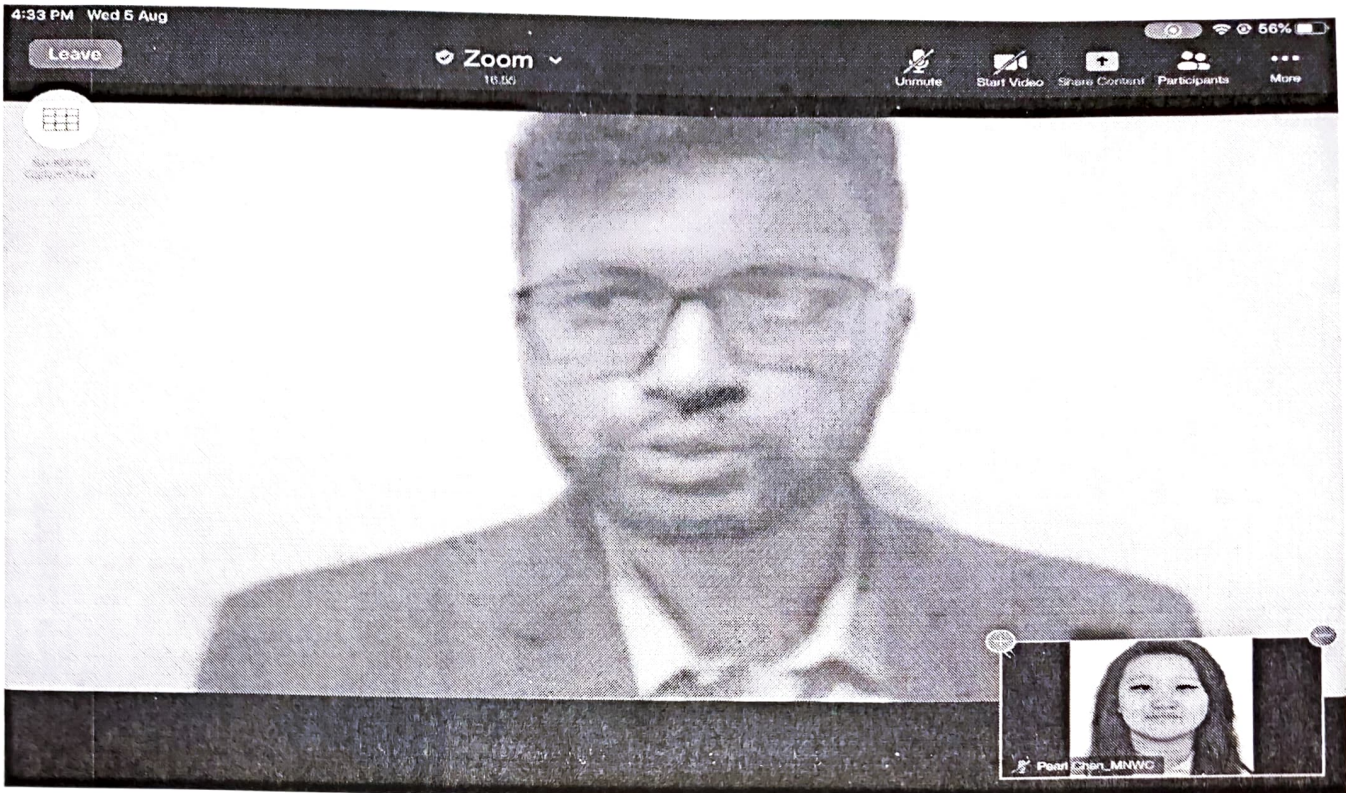

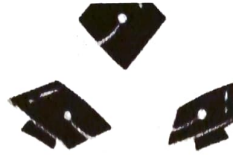
