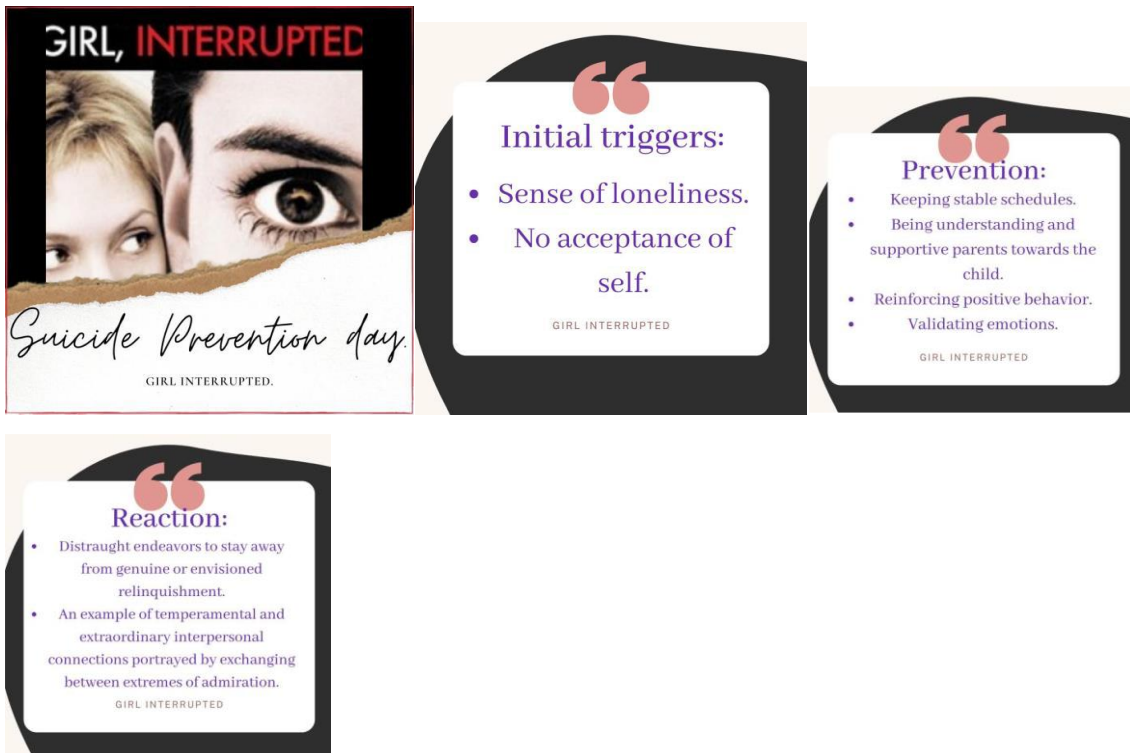

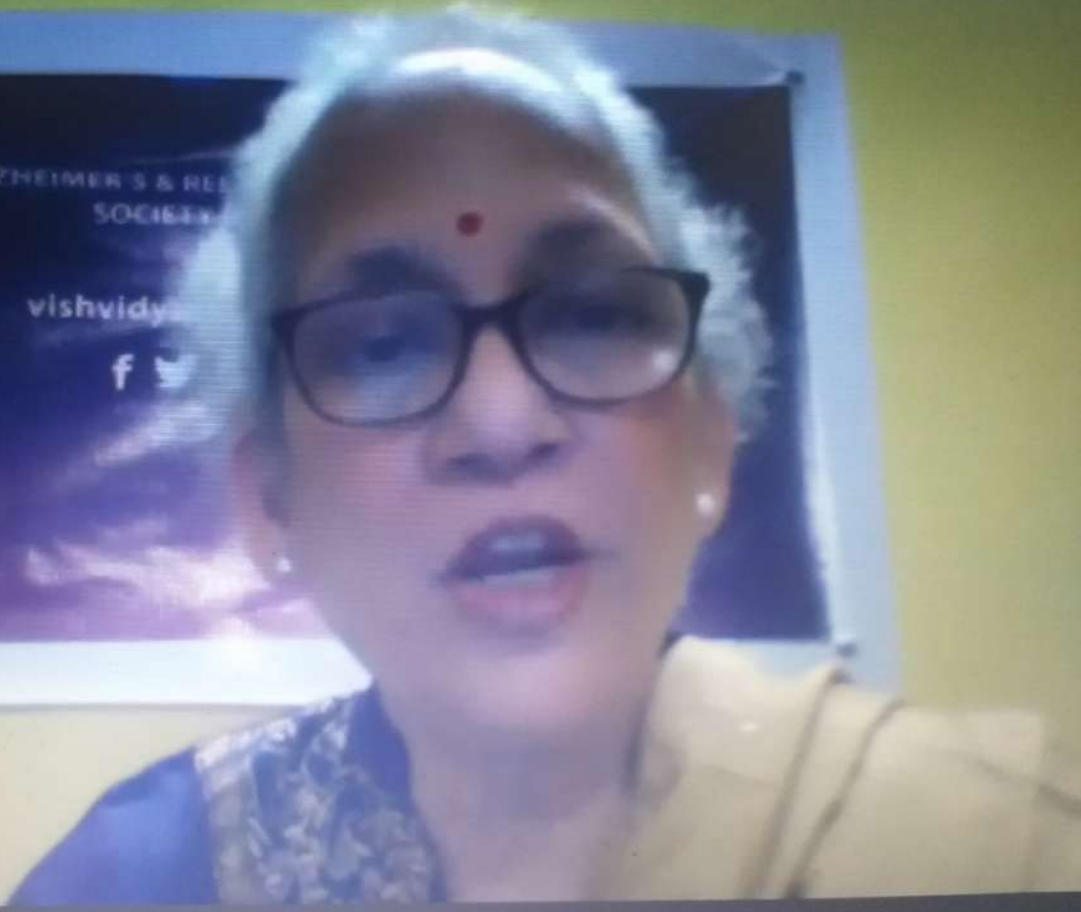

- (1) To celebrate Children's Day virtually.
- (2) To increase the bond between parents and child.
- (3) To enhance emotional development through small activities.

**METHODOLOGY: Participative, Experiential**

**OVERVIEW:**

**PRE-PREPARATION:**

The second-year students, of the Department of Child Development, organize a Children's Day program for pre-schoolers every year. This year, however, due to the lockdown, this program was conducted online which presented itself as a new learning opportunity for the students. The theme of the event (Lock your Bond in Unlock Time) was to celebrate the special bonding time that some parents and children got to experience in this lockdown

The preparation for the event was done in about 15 days. The event was divided into two days. The first day (10<sup>th</sup> Nov) was planned to focus primarily on the emotional development and the second day (12<sup>th</sup> Nov) included activities that focused on various other domains.

The entire batch was divided into teams such as the organizing team, the creative team, the PR team, etc, based on the interests and skills of the students. All the elements of the event, from the story, the puppets to the lyrics and composition of the 'Thank You' song were made by the students. The entire event was planned under the guidance of Dr. Swati Partani and Ms. Jaya Rajdev.

Keeping in mind the ongoing pandemic, this year, the event was conducted virtually using the Zoom application. The event was organized in remembrance of Pandit Jawaharlal Nehru's birth anniversary. It was a 2 days event held on the 10<sup>th</sup> and 12<sup>th</sup> of November 2020. The first day was

'Festival of Emotions' directed by Ms. Jaya Rajdev and the second day activities was organised by the second-year students of child development department under the guidance of Dr. Swati Partani.

### **10<sup>th</sup> November (Day1):**

The event started at 11:00 am with the host (Dr. Shital Parekh) welcoming all the children and the parents and gave a brief introduction about the Digipark event. Dr. Rajshree Trivedi, Principal of MNWC, acknowledged parents who took out time to join this event with their child/children and efforts put in by the Department of Child Development. This was followed by Dr. Swati Partani's presentation on developmental domains as all the activities were based on these domains. Then Ms. Jaya Rajdev gave a speech on the importance of emotional development. Then the host began with an ice-breaking activity 'Spin the Wheel' which the children enjoyed a lot as they had to make different emotional expressions shown on the wheel. The emotional festival included three creative activities which were conducted by students in different breakout rooms to keep the session interactive. The objective of these activities was to enhance emotional development in children.

### **Breakout Room Activities:**

#### **1. Colour Your Heart**

The activity helped them to recognise their emotions such as happy, sad, angry, surprised, etc, by colouring their heart with different colours for each emotion provided. The purpose of the activity was also to make children friends with their emotions and make them understand that each emotion is important.

#### **2. Friendship Medal**

In this activity, both, the parent and child were asked to make medals for each other to celebrate their friendship. They were also asked to write their favourite quality of each other on the medal.

#### **3. Roti Pizza**

Roti Pizza activity focused on enhancing emotional development through identification of emotions experienced in daily routine activities.

After returning to the main session, children expressed their happiness and enjoyment for doing the activities. The last one was a 'Music and Movement' activity which involved the development of gross motor skills. Bidding adieu to the children, the host hoped to see them on the 2nd day of the event which held a surprise in store for them.



## **12<sup>th</sup> November (Day 2):**

Starting the event at 11:00 am, one of the students (Bhoomi Bhateya) dressed up as Chacha Nehru and surprised the children and expressed his love and affection towards them. The first activity was 'Boogie Woogie', a music and movement activity (conducted by Archana Baitalik), which the children enjoyed a lot.

The host added an interesting element for the children by making use of a puppet monkey while interacting with them. The second activity was a riddle-based game 'Pandora's Box' in which a magician (played by Kajal Jaiswal) described different objects which the children had to identify. This game primarily focused on developing abstract thinking. The next activity was 'Dhundo toh Jano' (conducted by Nupur Hathi) wherein children were shown certain clues (ex: a colour, a letter, a shape, etc) based on which they had to bring the objects. The focus of this activity was to enhance cognitive development. The event continued with a story-telling session 'Tell a Tale'. This story was relevant to the current lockdown situation, it also suggested some ideas that may help make the parent-child bond even stronger. The story was told through a puppet show.

The judges for the video contest 'Bond Time in Quarantine' were Dr. Mihir Parekh and Ms. Sushma Mishra. The results of the contest were announced by Dr. Mihir Parekh. He appreciated the team and its effort for organizing a wonderful event with such an important theme (Parent-child bond).

As a memento for the event, the children were asked to plant a small moong sapling and give it their desired names. The event ended as a 'Thank You' song was played, devoted to all the parents and children for their lovely participation and making the whole event successful.

## **OUTCOME:**

Along with children, parents too enjoyed doing the activities and they thoroughly appreciated the efforts of the team for conducting such an event that was developmentally designed. The activities were planned to cater to the abilities of all the children from different age groups (3-6 years). The participants showed their interest in joining the future events of the department. It was a great opportunity for the students of MNWC of Child Development Department for interacting with children virtually and had an amazing experience.

**Taboos** that have preserved many endangered species in **Arunachal Pradesh**, explore the **Apatani tribe** whose villages have been described by UNESCO as living cultural landscape and learn how they live in harmony with their surroundings.

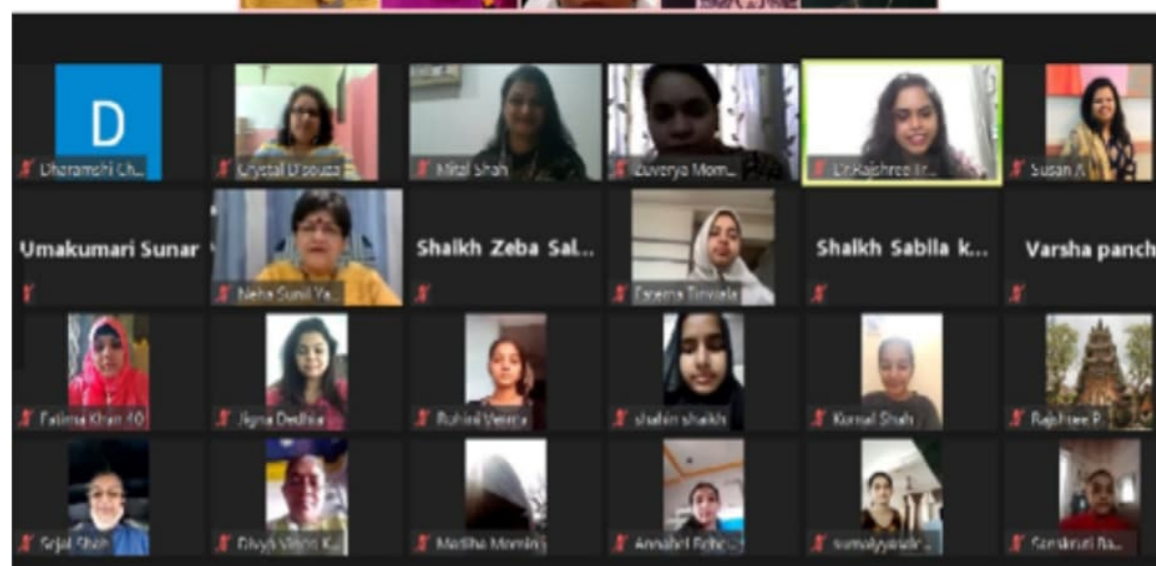
**METHODOLOGY:** Interactive and Creative communication session.



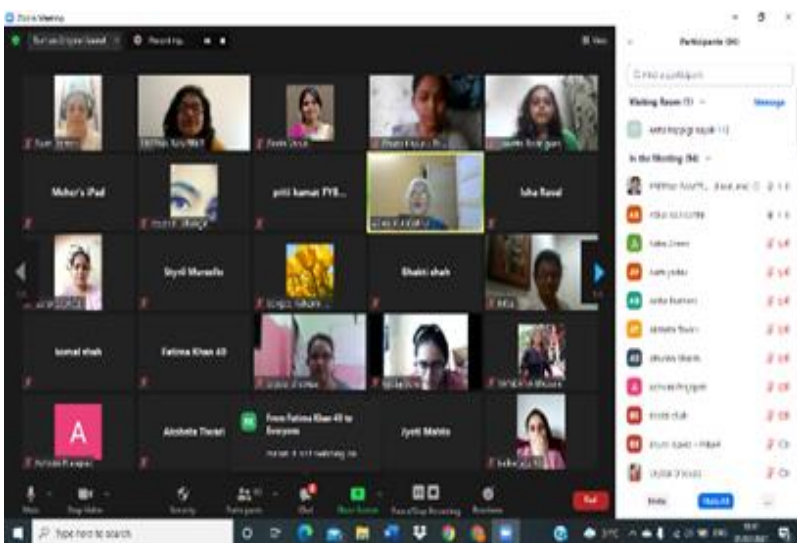

## **WORLD SUICIDE PREVENTION CAMPAIGN REPORT- 2020**

The students of the PG Dept. of Psychology ran an online awareness campaign beginning from the World Suicide Prevention Campaign in Sept 2020 to World Mental Health Day (Oct 2020). This month long effort was a composite of various themes related to mental health pertaining to the clinical psychology and counseling psychology specializations, while also covering aspects of life deeply affected by the pandemic.

The events were flagged with a video message by our Principal, Dr Rajshree Trivedi. The suicide prevention posts were designed to spread awareness, battle stigma, and provide support to those in mental distress. A poster competition titled “You are not alone” and an Instagram Live with Ms. Sayali Vartak, an alumna associated with Samaritans (an established suicide helpline) were the key events organized on that day.

The dept Instagram handle @selfcarecentral\_mnwc then rolled out a series of posts spanning different topics, starting from psycho-education related to various common conditions like depression, ADHD, OCD, along with hosting live events with practitioners like Chintan Naik, who spoke about OCD. Basic building blocks of mental health, like emotion regulation, self-compassion, understanding mental health from a gender lens, were also covered in these posts in practical and relatable ways.

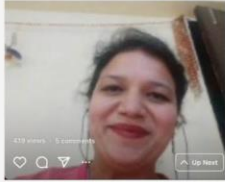
The students also recognized and covered challenges that rose specifically in relation to living with the pandemic through themes like unemployment, difficulties in online education, toxic productivity, and sleep quality, thereby making this campaign real-to-life. Lots of interactive activities and polls were used to secure engagement. The students also encouraged the audience to personalize and apply the concepts to themselves through templates, like for grounding and self-compassion. Details of helplines and resources were also shared and archived for the audience.

Keeping in mind that mental health is affected by larger systems, we devoted some time on the page to understand forces like patriarchy and hetero-normativity that put some individuals at greater disadvantage than others in our society. The students also covered the current legislative measure for mental health in India, the Mental Health Care Act of 2017, and ran a segment on Mental Health First Aid which was truly an urgent requirement for each and every individual considering the mental health toll of the pandemic.

The campaign ended with an essay writing competition on the theme of “Everyday Kindness” which also the World Mental Health Day theme for 2020. The students used

Instagram features like posts, polls, IG Live, along with well curated content backed by science and evidence for credibility. The month long effort showed us how even when we are physically distanced, social media can be effectively leveraged as a tool to promote mental health literacy and share practical tools and tips that one may otherwise not have access to.

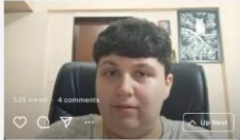

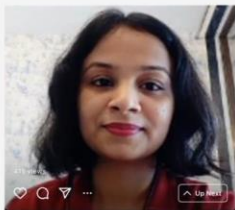

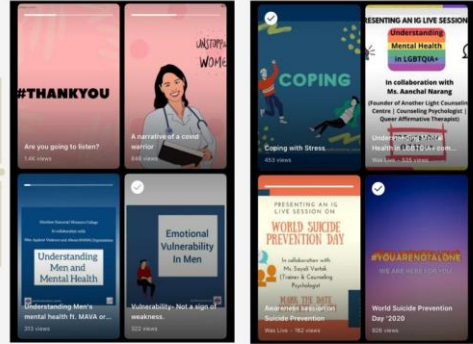


The session ended with the students thanking sir for his valuable time and knowledge.

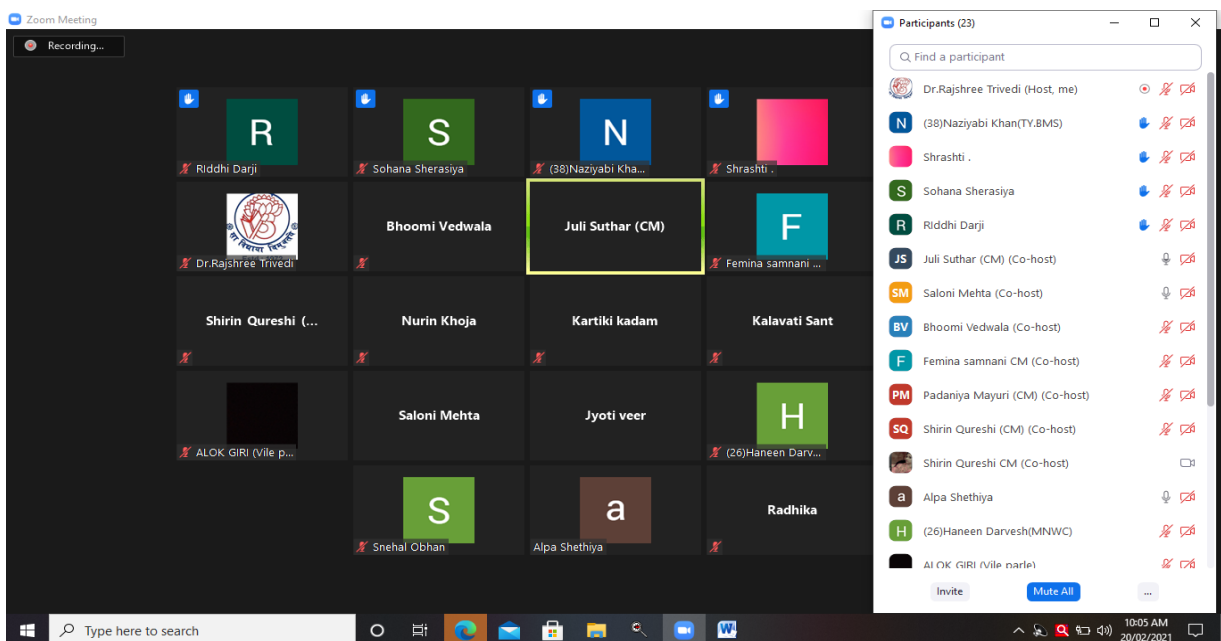

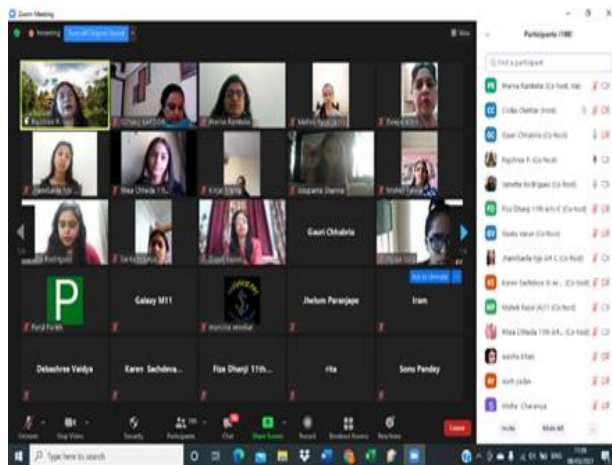
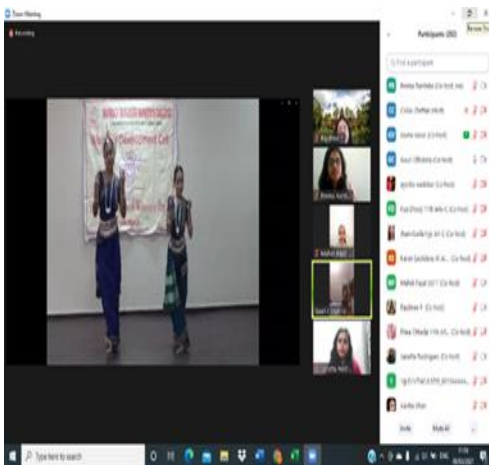
