# About the Centre:

Maniben Nanavati Women's College has been named after Smt. Maniben Chandulal Nanavati, fondly known as. "Mani Ba' or "Khadi Mata." She was a freedom fighter, social reformer and a staunch follower of Gandhian principles. She was closely associated with Mahatma Gandhi during the Indian freedom movement and had been jailed many times for her nationalist activities. The College upholds and follows her legacy till date and will continue to do so for all times.

The Gandhian Study Centre of Maniben Nanavati Women's College was established in 2010 under the Scheme of Epoch Making Social Thinkers of India by University Grants Commission, a government recognized body of India. Since then the Centre has been actively involved in instilling Gandhian values among the youth. The Centre has done extensive work in promoting Gandhian values and philosophy which includes publication of 2 books, organizing lectures, workshops, visits, short play competitions and research competition. Students carry out practical activities at the centre in the form of making paper bags, cloth bags, collection and sharing of used toys, holding sale and exhibition of khadi and cottage industry products, campus cleaning, offering services to municipal and NGO- run schools and others. In collaboration with the Sarvodaya Mandal, Mumbai, the centre conducts an examination based on Mahatma Gandhi's autobiography – My Experiments with Truth -every year for the National Service Scheme (NSS) volunteers. Some of the Gandhian scholars who have visited the College are Shri Tushar Gandhi, Sarlaben Mehta, Ushaben Thakkar, Sonal ben Parikh (the 5<sup>th</sup> direct descendent of Gandhiji), Kanubhai Suchak and others.

His ideals and way of life has been unquestionably accepted and practised all over the world.
