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Process of Feedback

Feedback is an essential aspect of any institution that contributes to its development and growth. The institute ensures that all the stakeholders are involved in the participatory management practice. Their valuable inputs are considered and executed upon so as to strengthen the vision, mission and goals of the institution.

The college follows an elaborate feedback system that includes feedback from the students, teachers and alumni. Initially as part of the evaluation period, a more general feedback was taken from students, alumni, parents and teachers.

Each year the students in final year gave an exit poll which elaborated the feedback on syllabus, course structure, teaching and facilities provided. Based on student feedback, guest lectures, activities and workshops are planned to enhance the learning process and field readiness of the students.

The college has been taking feedback on teaching methods and effectiveness of each teacher. This is then given to teachers confidentially by the Principal at the end of the academic year. The teachers are encouraged to implement various strategies to improve teaching effectiveness and generate students' interest.

The library has a structured format for receiving feedback from students. The College Library maintains a well-organized feedback mechanism in order to improve its services for book bank, issuing, addition of new books, Reprographic services, Internet facility and OPAC facilities.



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Since the academic year 2018-2019, the college introduced specific templates to further assess feedback on curricular aspects from students, teachers and alumni.

For students who were employed or completed internship, the feedback is collected from the employers by their respective departments. The departments then work on the training of students based on the feedback obtained.

An informal feedback system for students exists in college in the form of a suggestion box. This box is opened in front of the principal every month. The suggestions are positively taken and they are executed wherever possible.

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


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


Rate the curriculum prescribed for your degree during your term in the college? 117 responses





How do you rate the courses that you have learnt in relation to career prospects? 117 responses







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Alumni Feedback 2019-20

From all streams 116 students responded their feedback through a Google form. More than 75% alumni opined that curriculum prescribed for their degree course was very good and excellent. Less than 5% thought it to be average. About 65% said that curriculum was good or very good and as per their expectations. About 5% said that it was average. All alumni barring than 5% thought that academic initiatives taken by the institution to bridge the gap between academia and industry were good, very good and excellent. Same responses were obtained for new skills learnt in the course of their studies (96.6% said excellent, very good and good; 4% said average). For curriculum enhancing communication, critical thinking, problem solving and creativity 33% said excellent, 41% answered very good, 22.2% said good and less than 5% thought it to be average. For further studies 93.5 rated the curriculum to be good, very good and excellent and only 6.5% rated it to be average.

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


1. Rate the curriculum studied by the students.


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

4. Contribution of the curriculum towards getting job market ready. 146 responses






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
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5. Contribution of the curriculum towards developing Entrepreneurial skills/self-development. 146 responses



6. Scope of the curriculum for further studies. 146 responses






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7. How would you rate the co-curricular courses (MOOCs, yoga, etc.) provided by college to ensure the holistic development of students?

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Student Feedback 2019-20

One hundred and forty six students submitted the curriculum feedback through a Google form as the lockdown had begun. About 47% students rated the curriculum to be very good while 39% said it was excellent, for 13% it was very good. None of the students said that curriculum was average. When asked about the theoretical knowledge being justified with internship and placement opportunities, less than 1/4th said excellent. More than 40% said it to be very good. While 30% said good, a few thought it to be average. About the curriculum contributing to be job ready, 37% and 31% said good and very good respectively and 24% expressed that it was excellent and less than 10% responded as average.

Over 50% of the respondents answered that the curriculum developed entrepreneurial skills in them. Only 2% thought that curriculum was average for entrepreneurial skills. Good and very good was answered by 17 and 27% respectively. Except 4% all students all others said that there is a scope for further studies. About holistic development with programs like yoga and other cocurricular courses like MOOC, apart from 2.1%, rest all (97.9%) students rated the courses to be excellent, very good and good. RPTheon

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
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MANIBEN NANAVATI WOMEN'S COLLEGETEACHER FEEDBACK 2019-2020



B.M.S score good and B.A, B.Com and PG scored very good or excellent for the syllabi aim and objectives being well defined and clear to teachers and students. Whether the course followed the prescribed book, PG scored excellent and the rest scored very good. About the syllabus increasing the knowledge of the teachers, the response was very good for all except the B.M.S course. All streams were very good for the number of optional papers offered in that stream. The score for was highest for PG followed by B.A then B.Com and last B.M.S for the reference books being relevant, updated and appropriate.
