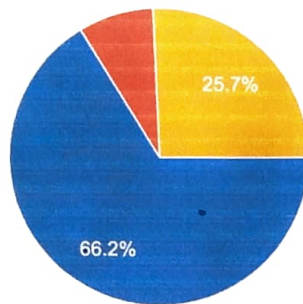

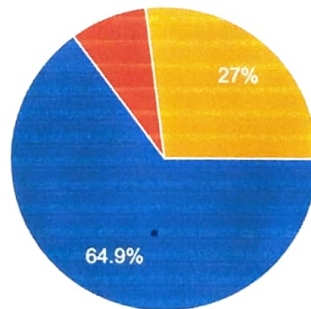

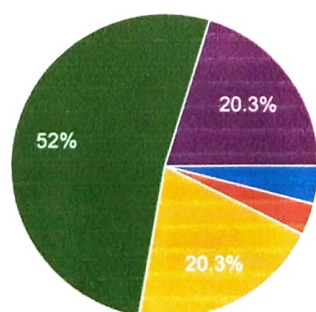

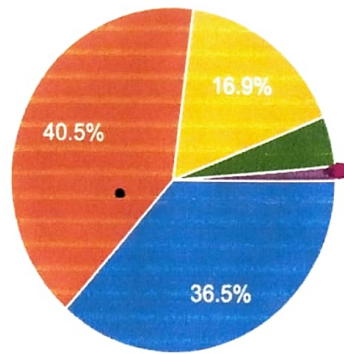

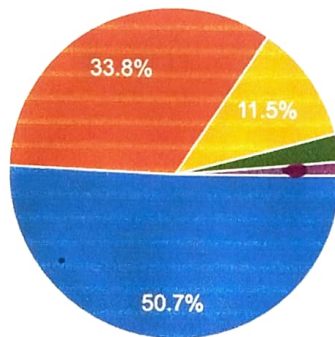

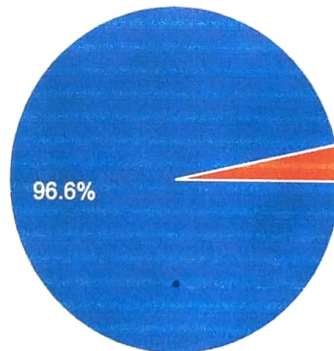

15. Concepts taught to you are supplemented with examples and applications.



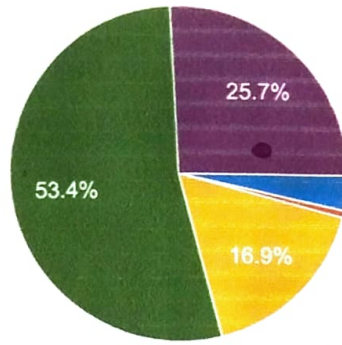

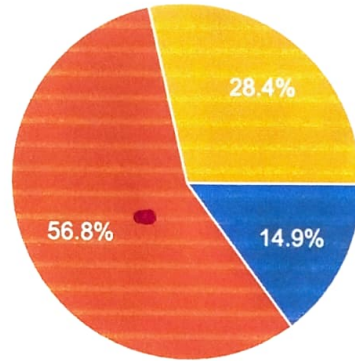

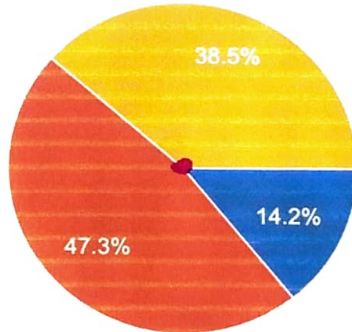

18. Rate Library Facilities Available



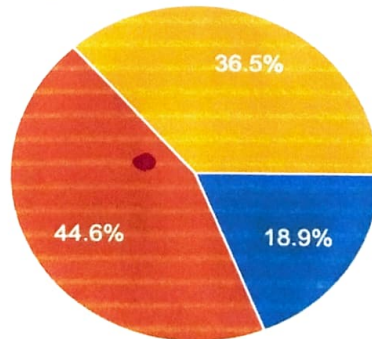
