- Principal Maam informed about renovation work at Psychology lab, Staff room Paintings to be done, IV and V floor cupboard painting work is on.

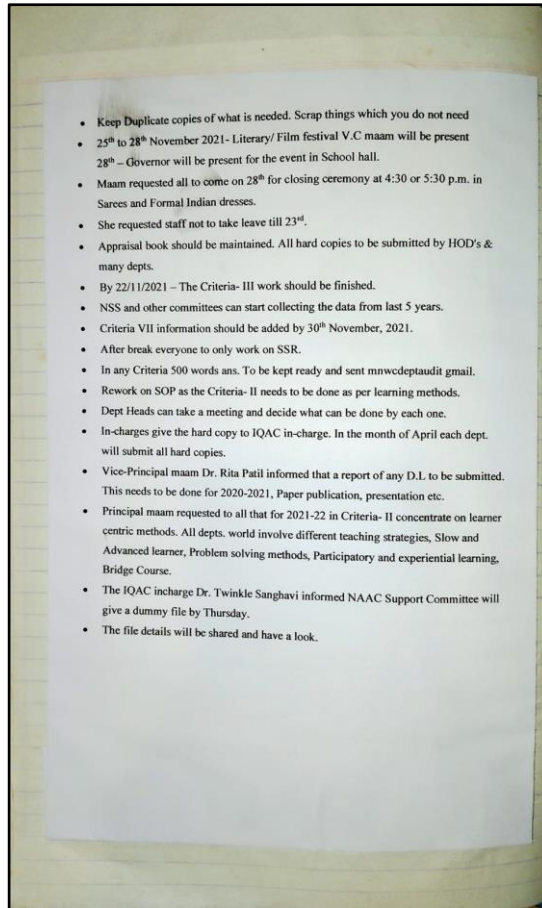
