He studied and practiced non-irrigation agricultural methods as solutions to water crisis which causes drought, thereby leading to Indian farmer suicides every year. This Water Gandhi of India found a mention in the Limca Book of Records for having

JIM looks to create a jan andolan for water, thereby making it everyone's priority.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has launched Jal Jeevan Mission on 15th August 2019. Under the Event, Central Government will bring piped water to households. Due to the water crisis in India Half of the country's households do not have access to piped water. Under the Jal
