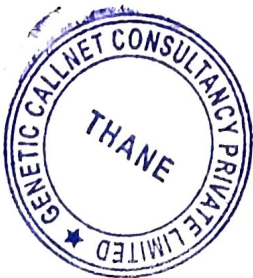

Maniben Nanavati Women's College has adopted a totally integrated approach to the development of women in all spheres- social and economic. The ultimate goal is to enable women to become good citizens and housewives and at the same time gain economic independence. The college also offers extension education in the form of various certificate courses and Diploma Courses for the women who for various reasons cannot take up full-time degree courses. It is affiliated to SNDT Women's University, Mumbai, which has an all India Jurisdiction.

Antarang Foundation works with underprivileged youth in the age group 17-28 years by conducting employability skills programs thereby managing the transition from education to employability.

The parties have had preliminary discussions in this matter and have ascertained areas of broad consensus. The parties now, have therefore, agreed to enter in writing these areas

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of consensus, under a Memorandum of Understanding.

The Plan

Antarang Foundation proposes to train young adults associated with Maniben Nanavati Women's College to achieve the following objectives through the CareerReady Program:

1. Facilitate a process of self-discovery, introduce various careers, facilitate an informed career choice and a coherent career plan.
2. Train them in core employability skills, connect them to career opportunities and mentors who will guide and advocate for them through the first year of their career.

Methodology of the CareerReady Program

CareerReady Program has classroom based training covering 5 modules:

1. Self-Awareness
2. Career Awareness
3. Work Skills
4. Work Ethics
5. Business English

All of the above is done through a variety of interactions with industry –through activities, projects, case studies, expert speakers and exposure visits.

Outcomes that are tracked and reported are:

- Student Enrollment
- Student Attendance
- Student's Interests, Aptitude, Personality and Learning Styles (self-awareness attributes)
- Employability Diagnostic – pre and post
- Student Graduation Rate
- Linkages to Education / Vocational Training Opportunities / Placements



The **deliverables** include:

1. Antarang will provide facilitation for 01 Career Ready batch of youth in the 17 to 28 year age group. Maniben Nanavati Women's College to share a time line for the start of the batch.
2. 40 sessions will be conducted over 4-5 days in a week for a duration of 2 hours each day.
3. Maniben Nanavati Women's College Teachers will enroll and mobilize youth for the batch of 40 students, monitor and support program milestones, ensure consistency in students' attendance throughout the program, follow up with drop-outs, invite parents for the parents meetings of the batch and ensuring 60% attendance of parents for the meeting.
4. Maniben Nanavati Women's College will provide a space for 3 hours a day (4 to 5 days a week) to conduct the sessions with a provision of space for storage of 30 tablets.
5. Maniben Nanavati Women's College and Antarang will provide a dedicated point of contact during program implementation.
6. Maniben Nanavati Women's College to work with Antarang post program to ensure that graduates take up opportunities provided and be a point of contact for Antarang.

Other Responsibilities:

- 1) The materials required for the program will be provided by Antarang.
- 2) Antarang will take complete ownership of the space during this period and any damages caused will be reimbursed/ repaired.

Fees and Payment schedule:

Maniben Nanavati Women's College is bound by no financial implications for the implementation of the CareerReady program for the students.

Duration of Assignment:

The duration for the assignment is for the period: 23rd July, 2019 – 30th September 2019.

Cancellation of the Contract:
