Details:

Pattern-making and Garment construction require bigger tables for the students to draft and lay fabric. While illustrating tables are supposed to be adjustable for students to draw/ illustrate design in their comfortable position. Hence, sizes and measurements were considered according to the needs of the subject, classroom, and space in the classroom.

Usha and Advance Juki machines consume different spaces and were settled in each class accordingly. Placement of each machine and equipment such as iron, iron board, overlock machine, stitching machines, and others were given specified space that will be feasible for usage. All this was done on the architectural app for a better view of classrooms and the size of machines were considered to fit.

Drape forms or dummies and mannequins were also placed according to subject and classrooms wherever it is required. Placement of these was tried and tested on the architectural app to save space.

Details:

Garment construction and pattern-making labs require mirrors for the students and their models to test the garment's look and fit. This requirement of the mirror, its size, and its placement in both labs were discussed and finalized.

The tracing table is a pattern-making lab requirement and has LED lights underneath a glass-top table for students to trace their repeated work to save time. Similarly, the size and placement of this tracing table were considered to be kept in the pattern-making lab.

As for the tracing table, the textile dyeing and printing lab needs to have a printing table. This table has fabric backing which will be stitched by the students. This table is required to be specifically used for printing and will keep the print process constricted to the table.

students have a subject of product and accessory making, for which, there was a requirement of extra shelves in the display cupboard/ Cabinet in the Illustration lab. These extra shelves will be used for the display of student work.

Lockers for students to keep daily required equipment, sheets, and other things. The size of the locker was decided as per the A3 sheets that are used by students to create and submit their portfolios. The placement of the locker, number of lockers, and size were finalized for easy usage.

Display boards in every class for students to pin their work on mood boards, theme boards, pattern-making, fabric swatches, etc.

The department's Window display will be a full-sized visual window for the students to present their garments on mannequins or drape forms. The size of the display will be such that approximately 2-3 mannequins will fit in them.
