



SERVICE AGREEMENT

THIS SERVICE AGREEMENT ("this Agreement")is made at Mumbai on this 20th day of October 2022.

BY AND BETWEEN

Dr.Bhanuben Nanavati Career Development Centre, (conducted by Shree Chandulal Nanavati Women's Institute & Girls' High School PAN- AAATS2863F), and having its registered office at Vallabhbhai Road, Vile Parle (West) Mumbai-400056, hereinafter referred to as "BNCDC"/ ("Facility Provider") represented through its Principal Dr.(Smt) Rajshree P. Trivedi, (which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include his heirs, executors, successors, administrators, and assigns) of the FIRST PART;

AND

Child n you, (PAN- AAATC7790D), an entity registered under the provisions of Charitable Act, and having its registered office at B/6 Aggarwal Estate, Chitalar, Manpada Off Godbunder Road, Thane (West) 400610, hereinafter referred to as "CNU"/ "Specialist" represented through its Trustee Mr. Nabhiraj Mehta (which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include his heirs, executors, successors, administrators, and assigns) of the SECOND PART:

Maniben Nanavati Women's College, having its registered office at Vallabhbhai Road, Vile Parle (West) hereafter referred to as "MNWC"/ ("Academic Partner") through its Principal Dr.(Smt) Rajshree P. Trivedi(which expression shall, unless it be repugnant to the context or meaning thereof, be deemed to mean and include his heirs, executors, successors, administrators, and assigns) of the THIRD PART;

The Facility Provider, the Specialist and Academic Partner are hereinafter collectively referred to as the "Parties" and individually as "Party", as the context may require

WHEREAS:

- BNCDC is an institution providing multiple educational courses even for people A. with minimum qualification and guiding their students from various backgrounds to be vocationally independent
- MNWC runs a "Divyangjan Cell" with an objective of empowerment of students B. with disabilities. MNWC conducts programs to create awareness and accept diversity as a part of human existence in its institutional practices. It further enables the atmosphere of respect and preserves the identities of the Divyangjan students. This cell facilitates teachers with knowledge and skills of using various aids and appliances required to cater needs of differently abled students. It further makes teaching more inclusive and cognizant for the Divyangjan students.
- CNU is a registered NGO (E-23206, Mumbai) working towards the advancement C. of special children with severe autism and multiple disabilities. CNU was formed in the year 2006 by like-minded people with the aim of making special children independent and inclusion in society. CNU is an educational and resource therapy center.
- BNCDC has the infrastructure, support staff and the administrative set-up D. necessary for facilitating the educational / skill development course for children with special needs.
- E. MNWC has the academic expertise to generally guide the Parties on academics.
- F. CNU has the practitioners and the industry professionals to undertake the teaching and training, classes for educational / skill development course for children with special needs.

The Parties have mutually decided to facilitate an educational / skill development course for children with special needs in the manner and on the terms agreed hereinunder.

NOW THIS AGREEMENT WITNESSETH AND IT IS HEREBY AGREED BY AND BETWEEN THE PARTIES HERETO AS FOLLOWS:



- The Parties have agreed to facilitate an educational / skill development course for children with special needs for a maximum total of 20(twenty) seats per year ("Diploma Programme") The Diploma Programme shall be for a period of 4(four) years ("1st December2022 to 30th November2026"). This Agreement is for a period of minimum 4(four) years
- 2. The Parties have agreed that CNU shall be entitled to admit and fill a total of atleast 80(Eighty) seats for the Diploma Programme for the entire Duration. The Parties have agreed that the Diploma Programme shall be of approximately a total of 1000(One thousand) hours per year and CNU shall be at liberty to decide the bifurcation of the same into online and offline in the manner it may deem fit
- The Parties have agreed that the Diploma Programme shall consist of the following subject:
 - (a) Ceramic Design;
 - (b) Textile Design;
 - (c) Fine Arts;
 - (d) Culinary Arts;
 - (e) Horticulture and Gardening.
- The Parties have agreed that each applicant child shall be tested and screened before securing the admission for the Diploma Programme in the manner recommended by CNU. The selection process of eligible student shall be done by CNU.
- The Parties have agreed that the Diploma Programme may be developed in collaboration with various industry professionals.
- 6. The Parties have agreed that the Diploma Programme may include as per availability, one studio visit per month to practice the subjects iterated in the Diploma Programme professionally. The Parties have agreed that the Diploma Programme may include as per availability, off-campus educational/training visits wherein the students would be taken to various design schools, institutes, factories, set-ups.

7. Rights and obligations of the Parties under this Agreement:



The Parties have agreed that BNCDC would provide the necessary infrastructural requirements in the form of classrooms and laboratory available and existing in the college in order to facilitate the smooth operation / functioning of the Diploma Programme including the following.

(i) The Diploma Programme shall be conducted at the premises of BNCDC

- (ii) The Parties have agreed that BNCDC shall provide all amenities(amenities includes classrooms, food laboratory, textile laboratory, drinking water facility, sanitation facilities, sound system, projector, laboratory equipment which are available and existing in the College)necessary for smooth facilitation of the Diploma Programme.
- (iii) BNCDC shall assign or appoint a liaison personnel (Ms Sudha Narkar-Centre Coordinator)who shall be in constant coordination with CNU, and such liaison personnel shall have the specific role of reviewing Diploma Programme conducted by CNU and to render all possible and reasonable assistance required for successful completion of the Diploma Programme.
- (iv) BNCDC shall issue and provide necessary letters and writings on its letterhead for fixing and enabling the training/studio visits for the Diploma Programme. The format of the letter will be provided by CNU which is acceptable to BNCDC.
- (v) Certificate for enrolled students shall bear BNCDC, MNWC and CNU name,logo, and signatures.
- (vi) BNCDC shall enable participation of students enrolled to the Diploma Programme in some selected college events to help enrolled students develop their social and various engaging skills.
- (vii) The Parties have agreed that BNCDC shall provide the necessary facilities available and existing in the college to ensure that the weekly time table for the education hours of the Diploma Programme is on course. The Parties have agreed that there shall be classes thrice a week which may be held during any day of the week(suitable to BNCDC) including Sundays. It is further agreed between the Parties that classes held during the week shall be of 5(five) hours and the same shall be of 7(seven) hours on Sundays
- (viii) The Parties have agreed that CNU shall approach BNCDC should there be requirement of any further assistance in the form of administrative staff and support staff for cleaning work classroom set up and to open and close classrooms which are available and existing in the college.
- (ix) The Parties have agreed that if for any force majeure reason(s) including lockdown, restriction(s) in movement of people imposed by the Central Government, State Government, local municipalities, or any other reason beyond the control of the Parties, the facilities to be provided by BNCDC for the Diploma Programme as iterated hereinabove becomes unavailable, unusable, not of safe quality BNCDC shall upon restoration


of the facilities as iterated hereinabove shall make the same available which is similar to their other course students to CNU for completion of the Diploma Programme. The Parties have agreed that this Agreement shall remain in force untill all students enrolled for the available 80(Eighty) seats have received certification of completion of the Diploma Programme and the tenure of this Agreement shall be extended until the completion of certification is received by all students enrolled for the available 80(Eighty) seats of the Diploma Programme. The Parties have agreed that this Agreement shall not terminated by either Parties under any circumstances during the tenure of this Agreement.

- (x) The Parties have agreed that the fees for the Diploma Programme to be decided/fixed by CNU shall be collected from each student by BNCDC on weekly, monthly, quarterly, biannual,or annual basis("Fees")
- (xi) The Parties have agreed that Fees of the programme /course will be Rs.1,50,000/-(Rupees One Lack Fifty Thousand Only)excluding material and training/studio visit cost per year. The Parties have agreed that for providing the facilities, and support setout hereinabove, an amount of Rs.25,000/-(Rupees Twenty-Five Thousand only)per student as facility cost shall be retained by BNCDC out of the course Fees collected from each student enrolled for the Diploma Programme("Facility Cost") It is hereby agreed, understood, and confirmed by the Parties that the Facility Cost collected by BNCDC shall mean to include the consideration for facility support to be provided by BNCDC and also the cost of the academic support to be provided by MNWC in the manner setout hereinabove
- (xii) The Parties have agreed that there will be a separate material and training/studio visit fees of Rs.50,000/-(Rupees fifty thousand only) approximately per year.And BNCDC shall allows CNU to collect material and training/studio visit fees from students directly It is hereby agreed,understood and confirmed by the parties that BNCDC has no share from the material and training/studio visit fees.
- (xiii) It is hereby agreed, understood, and confirmed by the Parties that the proportion of the Facility Cost payable between BNCDC and MNWC is to be internally understood between BNCDC and MNWC and CNU shall not be responsible for any dispute in this regard between BNCDC and MNWC.
- (xiv) The Parties have agreed that if there is an increase in the course fee (which is excluding material and training/studio visit fees)of the Diploma Programme, facility cost of BNCDC will also increase proportionately i.e.17% on increased fees per student (25000 plus 17% on increased

fees) This proportionate rate of 17% will be applicable till agreement period i.e from 1st December 2022 to 30th November, 2026)



- (xvi) The Parties have agreed that CNU shall ensure that the teachers, faculty, visiting faculty, and organizing studio visits,materials notes required for enabling the classes of the Diploma Programme, attend visit, and take the necessary classes of the Diploma Programme. Subject to compliance of the above terms by BNCDC and MNWC including providing the facilities(which is available and existing in the college) necessary for enabling facilitation of the Diploma Programme and transfer of the balance Fees from each enrolled student after deduction of Facility Cost to CNU in a timely manner, it is the sole responsibility of the CNU to complete the Diploma Programme of enrolled students
- (xvii) CNU shall be allowed to conduct the Diploma Programme in this agreement CNU agree that they shall not conduct any other courses or programme in the BNCDC premises.
- (xviii) Equipment(s) and movable property(ies) brought in by the CNU in the BNCDC premises will be the sole responsibility and liability of CNU including any damage or repair or maintenance to be carried out on such equipment(s) or property(ies).
- Governing Clause: The Parties have agreed that this Agreement shall be governed by the laws of India. All legal actions and proceedings if any relating herein shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts in Mumbai. All disputes, differences, claims and counterclaims arising whatsoever arising from this Agreement, such disputes, differences, claims and counterclaims shall be referred to arbitration in accordance with and subject to the provisions of The Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 or any statutory modification or reenactment thereof for the time being in force. The Parties have agreed that the arbitrator shall be a sole arbitrator and the arbitrator is to be decided mutually by the Parties. Such arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in English language and be held at Mumbai.

TERMS OF CONTRACT

Responsibilities of PARTY

- 1. INVESTMENT: PARTY shall have to pay a one time installation fee for the collection bin from EFI (NOTE: It shall be noted that the cost of a collection bin is Rs. 10,000/-)
- 2. PARTY shall provide 10sqft area of Property for setting up Collection Point at the mutually agreed location.
- 3. PARTY shall take responsibility that NO HAZARDOUS Material (Other than E-Waste) is added into the collection point.
- 4. When the Collection bin gets full the authorized person of PARTY must inform EFI for the collection of the material.
- 5. PARTY must protect the Bin against thieves, vandalizes.
- 6. PARTY need NOT pay EFI any disposal charges or collection fees of the EWaste generated from the Bin.

Responsibilities of Eco Friend Industries

- 1. It shall be noted that the Collection bin is the property of EFI.
- 2. EFI shall renew all its licenses and legal requirements as per the law of land.
- 3. EFI shall collect E-Waste promptly, within 72 hrs, as and when informed by PARTY's authorized person.
- 4. E-Waste shall be segregated, loaded and transported to EFI E-Waste Facility Navi Mumbai.

- 5. E-Waste shall be handled and disposed as per guidelines and directives of E-Waste management and handling rules and MPCB/CPCB.
- 6. EFI shall not charge PARTY for the Collection, Transportation, Handling, Management, Recycling and Disposal of E-Waste Generated at the Collection
- 7. All authorized material collected, as E-Waste from the Collection Point shall be the property of EFI.
- 8. E-Waste Material generated from the bin cannot be disposed, traded or sold to any other service provider or Bhangarwala or another E-Waste solution provider.
- 9. There shall not be any monetary exchange with EFI for E-Waste material
- EFI shall procure all necessary insurance for risks that may arise in the process of transportation of E-Waste from Collection Bins to EFI's facility.
- 11. EFI shall have sole right over any revenue (Advertising, Marketing, Promotional, Creative, Any Other) that may be generated from the bin.
- 12. EFI shall not charge any Transportation / Freight for the E-Waste that will be collected from the Collection Bin.
- 13. EFI shall not charge any Labour Expense for the E-Waste that will be collected from the Collection Bin.
- 14. EFI shall issue PARTY
 - a. Green certificate of Disposal
 - b. Form 6 (Manifest Copy)
 - c. Photocopy of the entry of disposal in CPCB registration Pass book

Joint Responsibilities of PARTY and EFI

- 1. The bin shall be made available to all and not exclusive to the PARTY to benefit public interest.
- 2. PARTY/EFI shall make all promotion and awareness activity to the best of their abilities for the success of our project.

DURATION

- 1. The term of this Agreement will commence on the date of signing this Agreement and, unless earlier terminated as provided herein, will continue for Ten Years (10 Years).
- 2. Either Party may terminate this Agreement immediately on written notice at any time the other Party commits any irremediable material breach of this Agreement or for the avoidance of doubt, but without limitation, commits any remediable breach of this Agreement and fails to remedy such breach within a period of thirty (30) days from the service on it of a notice specifying the breach and requiring it to be remedied or, having so remedied.

3. Either Party may terminate this Agreement, if a petition or application for winding up of the other Party has been admitted and a liquidator has been appointed or an order of bankruptcy or winding up or dissolution has been passed by competent courts.

CONFIDENTIALITY

Each Party shall keep this Agreement and all related information and correspondence provided to the other Party in strict confidence, and shall not disclose the same to any third party, except if required to be disclosed under Applicable Laws. For the purpose of this clause, Parties may enter into an appropriate confidentiality agreement.

FORCE MAJEURE

- Force Majeure means any event or a combination of event that materially or adversely affect the performance of either Parties of its obligation ("Affected Party") of its obligations in whole or in part, pursuant to the terms of this Agreement but only to the extent that such event or circumstances are not within the Affected Party's reasonable control and have not been caused by willful neglect or act or omission of the Affected Party. The following events shall constitute Force Majeure: epidemic, nuclear emergency, earthquake, riot, war, acts of terrorist.
- 2. In the event Force Majeure continues unabated for an uninterrupted period of 30 days either Party has a right to terminate this Agreement by providing prior written notice.

GOVERNING LAW & COURT OF JURISDICTION

The E-Waste Collection Agreement shall be governed by Law applicable in the state of India and Courts situated at Mumbai, Maharashtra will have exclusive jurisdiction in any matter arising out the contract.

NOTE:

It is important to note that this agreement can work on basis of Good Faith, Dedication and Commitment. EFI and PARTY will make all promotion and awareness to the best of their ability for the complete success of the 'E-Waste Collection Bin' Project.

6. EFI shall not charge PARTY for the Collection, Transportation, Handling, Management, Recycling and Disposal of E-Waste Generated at the Collection Bin.

7. All authorized material collected, as E-Waste from the Collection Point shall be the property of EFI.

8. E-Waste Material generated from the bin cannot be disposed, traded or sold to any other service provider or Bhangarwala or another E-Waste solution provider.

9. There shall not be any monetary exchange with EFI for E-Waste material collected.

10. EFI shall procure all necessary insurance for risks that may arise in the process of transportation of E-Waste from Collection Bins to EFI's facility.

11. EFI shall have sole right over any revenue (Advertising, Marketing, Promotional, Creative, Any Other) that may be generated from the bin.

12. EFI shall not charge any Transportation / Freight for the E-Waste that will be collected from the Collection Bin.

13. EFI shall not charge any Labour Expense for the E-Waste that will be collected from the Collection Bin.

14. EFI shall issue PARTY

a. Green certificate of Disposal

b. Form 6 (Manifest Copy)

c. Photocopy of the entry of disposal in CPCB registration Pass book

Joint Responsibilities of PARTY and EFI

1. The bin shall be made available to all and not exclusive to the PARTY to benefit public interest.

2. PARTY/EFI shall make all promotion and awareness activity to the best of their abilities for the success of our project.

DURATION

1. The term of this Agreement will commence on the date of signing this Agreement and, unless earlier terminated as provided herein, will continue for Ten Years (10 Years).

FORCE MAJEURE

- Force Majeure means any event or a combination of event that materially or adversely affect the performance of either Parties of its obligation ("Affected Party") of its obligations in whole or in part, pursuant to the terms of this Agreement but only to the extent that such event or circumstances are not within the Affected Party's reasonable control and have not been caused by willful neglect or act or omission of the Affected Party. The following events shall constitute Force Majeure: epidemic, nuclear emergency, earthquake, riot, war, acts of terrorist.
- 2. In the event Force Majeure continues unabated for an uninterrupted period of 30 days either Party has a right to terminate this Agreement by providing prior written notice.

GOVERNING LAW & COURT OF JURISDICTION

The E-Waste Collection Agreement shall be governed by Law applicable in the state of India and Courts situated at Mumbai, Maharashtra will have exclusive jurisdiction in any matter arising out the contract.
