We are delighted to offer you admission into the graduate program in the Department of Psychology at the University of Illinois Chicago for the academic year beginning August 2023. This offer is contingent upon UIC Graduate College requirements that include: verification of your academic record by the Office of Graduate Admissions as well as the successful completion of a criminal background check and other applicable pre-employment assessments.

We are happy to offer you an assistantship for the 9-month, 2023-2024 academic year with a minimum pay rate of \$23,440 (Fall and Spring semesters combined) for a 50% appointment. This assistantship will require you to work approximately 20 hours a week as either a Teaching Assistant (TA) or Research Assistant (RA). Although not guaranteed, additional support is provided to most students during the summer semester via either a TA or RA. Your percentage appointment may also differ based on your needs and the resources provided by your research mentor. The minimum appointment that includes a tuition waiver is 25% and the maximum that you can accept each semester is 67%. There are various forms of funding available, and the source of your funds may change during your years spent at UIC, but no matter the source of your funding, your tuition and most fees will be waived as long as you maintain a 25% appointment. Due to University regulations, we are only allowed to make formal assistantship and fellowship commitments one year in advance. With that said, it is our intention to support all students who are in good standing throughout their tenure in the program. If you are an international student, please be advised that any assistantship is contingent upon your meeting work eligibility requirements as established by the U.S. Federal I-9 Form. If you hold DACA status, any assistantship is contingent upon your maintenance of DACA status to meet work eligibility requirements. Any misrepresentation of work eligibility documents will result in immediate termination of employment.
