Internal Quality Assurance Cell

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell of the college has been conscious of its role of being a catalyst “to improve the academic and administrative performance of the institution.” Keeping the five core values recommended by National Assessment and Accreditation Council (NAAC) and the seven criteria for assessment under Quality Indicator Framework, the IQAC continuously works towards the sustainability of excellence levels in the institution. With the help of NAAC Support Committee, the IQAC strategically worked out plans in coordination with the Departments and Committees for the academic year 2022-2023.

One major change in academic was introduction of Academic Data Management System (ADMS) was designed by Dr. Twinkle Sanghavi and Dr. Anuja Deshpande under the leadership of Principal Dr. Rajshree Trivedi. This software will help the college data to come on one platform and can be viewed from anywhere at any time.

To maintain the quality of academic every year IQAC conducts Internal Academic Audit this year it was inter department academic audit as well as External Academic Audit was conducted by Dr. Pandurang Barkale, Consultant, Higher Education Rashtriya Uchchar Shiksha Abhiyan (RUSA), Dr. Malathi Iyer, Associate Professor at Vivek College of Commerce and Dr. Deepti Sadvelkar, Assistant Professor, Shree L.R. Tiwari College of Arts, Commerce and Science.

Under Career Advancement Scheme IQAC successfully completed 4 teachers and one librarian promotion process.

The following initiatives were undertaken:

1. Curriculum Aspects:

Most of the dept. carried out Add-on Course for final year students whereas for first years and second years IQAC planned MOOC course for all students for First year the course was on Fundamental of Computers, Internet, and social media and for Second Year on Advance Excel Course was done by the college free of cost.

2. Teaching – Learning & Evaluation:

- Teachers made good use of its our own designed Learning, Management System
- Under the MOUs signed by the Departments, various Faculty and Student Exchange Programmes were organized such as webinars, workshops, conferences, interactive sessions, and other activity.
- Enhancement of mentoring services to students.

- Three Teachers Dr. Twinkle Sanghavi, Dr. Anuja Deshpande, and Ms. Neha Bhansali attended Faculty development programme on new Teaching pedagogy.

3. Research, Innovations and Extension:

- Under the aegis of Smt. Kantaben Shah Research Centre for Multidisciplinary Studies, Short term research projects have been granted to 3 faculty members.
- Two faculties of Dept. Of Psychology Dr. Cicilia Chatter and Dr. Anuja Deshpande Co-edited the book “Unmasking the Future A Collection of Scholarly Essays on the Impact and aftermath of the Covid- 19 Crisis” many of the teachers at the institute have contributed to the book.
- 8 Teachers published their paper in UGC approved Journals whereas 21 paper got published in Peer reviewed journals.
- 2 Teachers published their chapter in book related to their streams.
- Student Aid for Research (S.T.A.R.) In order to train interested undergraduate students in research, KSRC initiated a program titled Student Aid for Research (S.T.A.R.), where two departments, in rotation every year, are trained by an external researcher in the process of research. The project began with Psychology and Sociology, under the guidance of the director, Dr. S.M. Michael, Institute of Indian Culture (IIC, Mumbai). Ms. Veronica Pinto served as the research coordinator. Students completed two projects which were presented by them as a research study. The following year, the departments of B. Com and B.A. (Economics) were selected for participation. They were guided by Dr. Vinod Kamble and their department faculty served as research co-ordinators. Dr.Rekha Kaklotar, Dr. Rita Chandrana and Ms. Pranaya Revandkar provide the students with much needed support through their research journey. This year students participated in the research paper competition where they stood third with their research work, attracting a cash prize of Rs. 2000/-

4. Infrastructure and Learning Resources:
