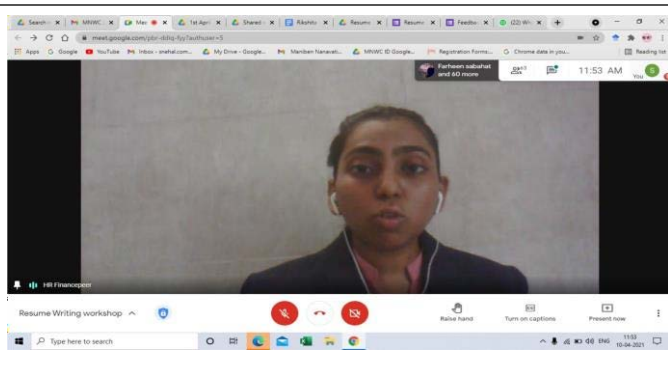

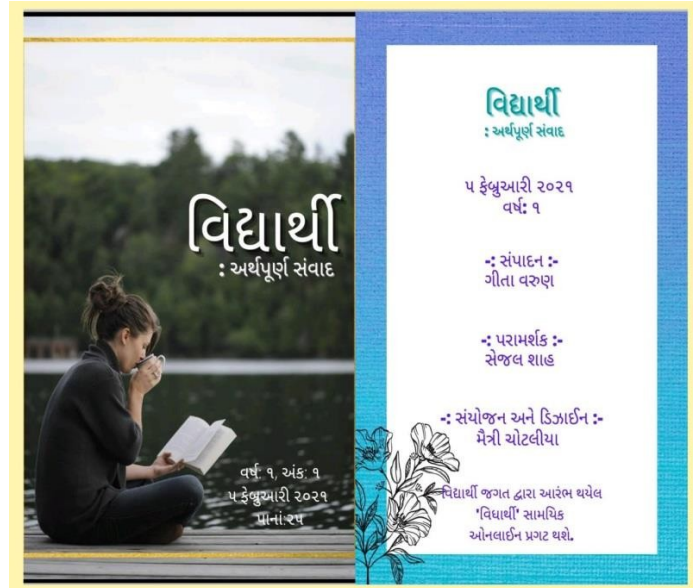

### **Alumni Contribution :**

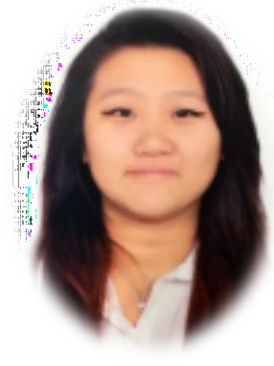
