Phase 1: Abstract Submission Last Date: 10th February, 2026

Phase 2: Full Paper Submission Last Date: 11th February, 2026

- 3000-5000 words (excluding references and appendices)
- Format: APA/MLA style as discipline-appropriate
- Originality report through plagiarism-check software required

Phase 3: Final Presentation

- Live virtual presentation
- Slides submission last date 10th February, 2026

5. Research Paper Requirements

- Original, unpublished research
- Empirical, theoretical, or applied research accepted
- Interdisciplinary work encouraged
- Must include: Introduction, Literature Review and References
- Ethical compliance must be ensure

8. Technical Requirements for Online Participation

- Stable internet connection
- Webcam and microphone
- Presentation software (PowerPoint/Google Slides/Keynote)
- Backup presentation file submission mandatory

9. Prizes & Recognition

- First Prize: 3000 + Certificate + Publication opportunity
- Second Prize: 2000 + Certificate
- Third Prize: 1000 + Certificate
- 2 Consolation Prizes: ₹500 each + Certificate
